THE LAW OF GOD - ABBY

(Exodus 20:1-17)

(SILENCE)

In your mercy forgive what we have been, help us amend what we are,

to the glory of your holy name.**

**Jesus, Lamb of God, have mercy on us.
Jesus, bearer of our sins, have mercy on us.
Jesus, redeemer of the world, grant us peace.**

DECLARATION OF FORGIVENESS - DAD

Hear the good news!
The saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to
save sinners.
He himself bore our sins
in his body on the cross,
that we might be dead to sin, and alive to all that is good.
I declare to you in the name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven.
Amen.
(1 Tim. 1:15; 1 Peter 2:24)

EXHORTATION - MOM

as freely as God has forgiven you.
